Dr. McIntosh has consulted extensively on the developmental issues surrounding legislation of shared time parenting for children, specifically young children, and children in family court populations, living with high levels of acrimony between their parents. Her position on the topic is not gendered or rights based, but is grounded in a view that chief amongst the considerations involved must be the developmental needs of the child.

She has led two significant studies into these issues, conducted with fellow academics, Ass. Prof. Bruce Smyth, Ass. Prof. Margaret Kelaher, and Prof Yvonne Wells. Dr. McIntosh gave evidence about this work to the House Of Commons, London, May 2011, informing their legislative enquiry. She has this year also spoken in Ireland, several states in the USA, New Zealand and Australia.
